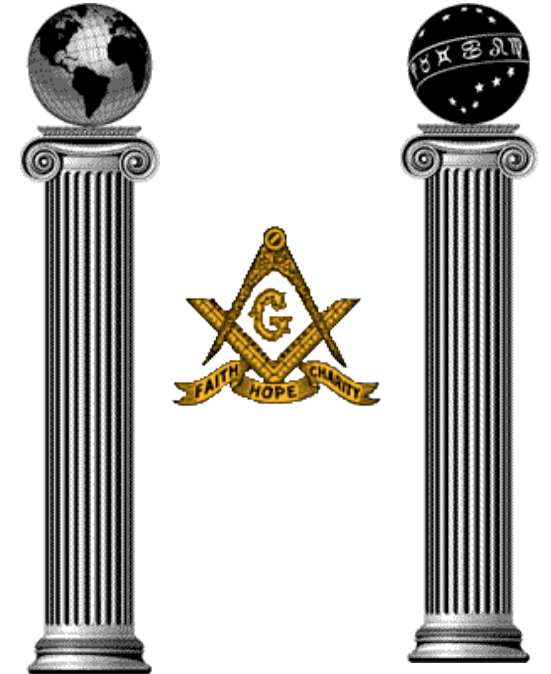

MASONIC TRIVIA

The oldest known Masonic document is the Halliwell Manuscript (aka The "Regius Poem") consists of 64 written pages in poetic form. The poem begins by evoking Euclid and his invention of geometry in ancient Egypt, followed by fifteen points for the master concerning both moral behavior and operation work. The document first printed in 1390 from an earlier hand written one, is 327 years older than the formation of the Grand Lodge of England in 1717.
