MASONIC TRIVIA

In 1861, General George B. McClellan was made general-in-chief of the Union armies by US President Abraham Lincoln. He directed the peninsula campaign in 1862, and commanded at Antietam in September of 1862. He was replaced by General Burnside in that year. In 1864, he became the Democratic candidate for President but was defeated by Lincoln.

Brother McClellan received all three degrees in Free-masonry on December 9, 1853, in Willamette Lodge No 2, Portland, OR, by special dispensation of the Grand Master. Brother Gen. George B. McClellan died on October 29, 1885.
