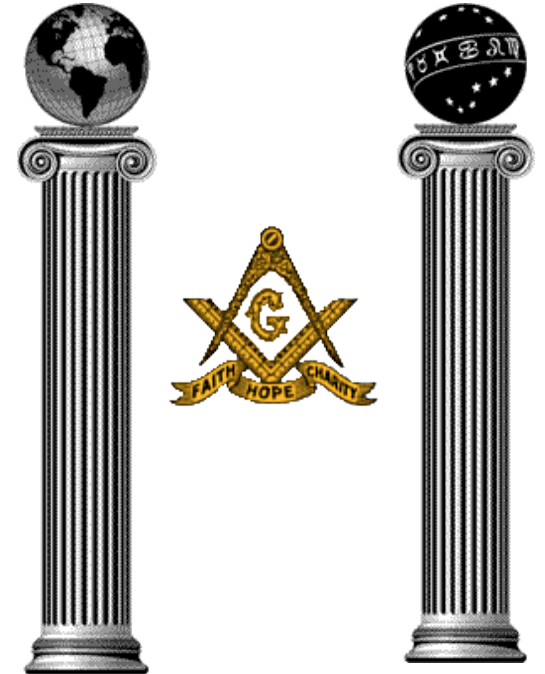

**TRIVIA**

In last month notice, the questions was if you could name the three types of masonic lodges in the U.S.

Here is the answer...

Lodges and Grand Lodges whose charters' roots derive from the United Grand Lodge of Ancient Freemasons of England, The Grand Lodge of Ireland or the Grand Lodge of Ancient Free and Accepted Masons of Scotland use the expression, A.F. & A.M.

Lodges and Grand Lodges that don't use the appellation "Ancient", claim descent from the "Grand Lodge of Free and Accepted Masons under the constitution of England" and thus use the expression, F. & A.M.

The third came from the merger of two older Grand Lodges. The Grand Lodge of Ancient Masons and the Grand Lodge of Ancient York Masons and thus use the expression A.F.M. or Ancient Free Masons. There is only one Grand Lodge and lodges that uses this expression and it the Grand Lodge of South Carolina.
