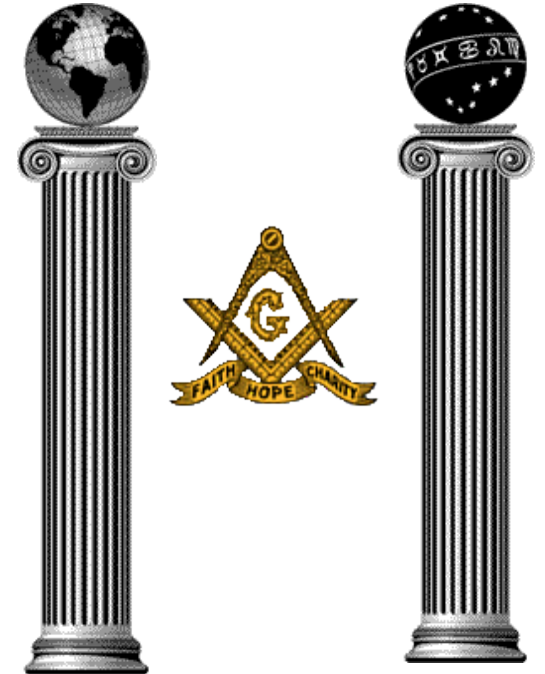

MASONIC HISTORY

Here are some interesting facts regarding famous people involved in the Battle of the Alamo, an important chapter in American history. We have all heard of this famous battle I'm sure, but are we aware of the Masonic connections that of some of these well known participants had during their lives?

Bro William Barret Travis
(08/09/1809 – 03/06/1836)
Alabama Lodge No. 3

Bro Davey Crockett
(08/17/1786 - 03/06/1836)
lodge unknown

Bro James Butler Bonham
(02/20/1807– 03/06/1836)
So. Carolina lodge records destroyed by fire in 1838

Bro James "Jim" Bowie
(04/10/1796 – 03/06/1836)
Loge L'Humble Chaumiere No. 19, Opelousas, La

Bro Almaron Dickinson
(1814 – 03/06/1836)
Alabama Lodge No. 3

One of the few who survived the massacre at the Alamo was Mrs. Almaron Dickenson (Suzanna) who had been advised by her husband to display his Masonic apron over herself and his daughter during and after the battle. Santa Anna saw to her needs and even offered to adopt her child. She declined the offer declaring that she would "crawl and work her fingers to the bone to support the baby, but that she would rather see the child starve than given into the hands of the author of so much horror."
